

**Zorb Ball Footrace**  
**Terms & Conditions**  
**Wentworth Park Greyhounds**  
**Operated by the NSW Greyhound Breeders, Owners and Trainers Association**

1. The Zorb Ball footrace will be conducted on Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> January 2019 at Wentworth Park Greyhounds, Wentworth Park Road, Glebe NSW 2037. This will be a stand-alone event.
2. All persons aged 18 years and under must have parental consent to enter the competition. Please note that children aged 18 years and under must be accompanied by a paying adult when entering Wentworth Park greyhounds.
3. All persons entering Wentworth Park on Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> January 2019 will be issued with an entry ticket for entry into the Zorb Ball footrace. Please note that persons aged under 18 years will only be issued an entry ticket if accompanied by a paying adult.
4. Entrants will be required to complete the details on their ticket, and place it in the relevant barrel, located on the Ground level, next to the Race Night Office.
5. Should a patron holding a ticket not wish to participate, they may provide their blank entry ticket to another person. Entrants may complete more than one entry.
6. Entry forms must be completed in full to be eligible, including the patron's signature releasing the NSW GBOTA, Wentworth Park Sporting Complex from any action following the event.
7. Entry tickets for children under the age of 18 must have been signed by a parent or guardian.
8. Entries will close at 8.00pm. Entries will be drawn following the close of entries.
9. A total of two (2) entries will be drawn to participate in the footrace.
10. Drawn contestants should make themselves known to Staff at the Race Night office immediately after their name is called out.
11. Contestants will be required to comply with directives issued by NSW GBOTA Staff. Contestants will be briefed at this point to the running of the competition and OH&S guidelines.
12. Contestants must have appropriate footwear to compete, no person shall be allowed to compete in bare feet, open shoes or high heels.
13. Following the running of Race 4, at approximately 8.30pm, entrants will be taken on to the track for the footrace.
14. The footrace will be undertaken down the length of the track straight. Start and finish will be clearly marked by Race night staff.

15. The winner of the Zorb Ball footrace will receive \$200.00 in cash.
16. The NSW GBOTA official present will be responsible for the final decision and no discussion will be entered into regarding decision.
17. Winning contestants will be required to fill in a payment declaration form to claim winning monies. Note that winning contestants under the age of 18 will require parental consent to claim their prize.
18. Contestants participating do so at their own risk, and in completing the entry form, release all parties involved in the promotion of the event.
19. Decisions made by officials of the competition are final, no discussion will be entered into regarding decisions.
